- Dining facilities (800 pax)
- Bars: 4 main bars & 4 Tiki bars
- Transportation area (120 pax)
- Staff facilities
- External fixtures and fittings: 2,000 beach chairs, 1,000 umbrellas, and 77 beach cabanas
