Scope of Work Master-planning Pre-concept design

Katara Park is set to be the largest national park in Doha, with a total built-up area of 577,000 m². The park's design adopts a "Hills & Valleys" theme featuring diverse landscaped areas. The park is divided into north and south zones with plot areas of 280,000 m² and 297,000m², respectively. The two zones encompass various areas and activities as follows:

- Relaxation area: residential bungalows, hotels, and spas
- Tropical forest areas hosting a wide variety of plants
- Adventure area: amusing activities (such as play areas with historical themes), steep man-made hills with

The South Zone, which is larger than the North Zone, is planned as a commercial and gathering zone at the entrance, with a number of greenhouses.
